

Holyland Virtual Tour Demo Presentation

Have you ever tried to sell a music band's CD by just showing the cover? It usually does not sell very well. However, invite that same band to do one or two songs, then offer the CD in the foyer and you would see a real difference in response. The same goes for the Holyland Virtual Tour CD-ROM. Most people will see this CD title on the shelf and never know how much it would enrich their walk through the Bible. Some people have even been burned by poorly made CD tours and do not realize that the Holyland Virtual Tour has over 50 locations full of various media, rich information, and an extremely easy-to-use interface. So to truly gain the joy and impact of this CD-ROM, it has to be seen in action. There are two ways this can be done.

Take the "Walkthrough Demo" as listed on the opening screen and recreate the same presentation to your congregation. This way is very convenient; however, there would be no CDs available afterward unless a bulk supply is pre-ordered in advance. Note: pre-orders can be noted and made available the following week. There might also be a limitation of payment options as well.

There is another way, invite the author to come and give a demonstration (much like a guest music band). The presentation would last according to the amount of time you desire, anywhere from 10 minutes to an entire service. Afterward, the CDs would be made available for purchase at a discount rate. Again, depending on the size of your congregation, this may be a pre-order and the CDs made available the following week.

If you would like to have the Holyland Virtual Tour demonstrated, then all that is needed are the following.

1. An open date for which to come.
2. Round-trip travel expenses from Southern California. (Near San Bernardino and Riverside)
3. A projector system for a laptop computer. (VGA)
4. An audio feed to the laptop computer. (stereo mini)
5. A table on which to sell the CD-ROMs after service.

There are two people that can perform the demonstration.

Rick Schneblin, the author of the Holyland Virtual tour, can do any short, concise demonstration, or a longer presentation that will relate stories regarding the trials, tribulations and miracles in producing the media and share special points of interest in Israel and Jordan. The other could be to have Bob Probert, the virtual tour guide of the Holyland Virtual Tour, give a full sermon on one of the places mentioned in the CD. Sometimes both can be used. Bob Probert gives a sermon based on a chosen location while Rick Schneblin shows the media while he speaks.

Please let us know your preference. We are both here to serve you, your congregation and the Lord Jesus.
